

A CONNECTED TOWN

New Breeze has evolved as a thriving community centred around transport, educational and social facilities including Bardia Public School, Edmondson Park Train Station and Ed Square Town Centre. The community provides a diverse range of high density (small lot housing) in a well-connected and walkable urban environment, centred around 40 hectares of green corridors.

AN ACTIVE TOWN

Large high-quality parks and playgrounds, a sports oval, bike and walking paths and 40 hectares of open spaces for recreational activities that envelope the development to create a green corridor.

A LIVEABLE TOWN

A masterplan design
that maximises smaller lots
fronting parks and open space
corridors resulting in higher
utilisation of open space
by the local community.
Further the design responds
to the natural topography and
constraints by setting larger
lots against the sloping land to
the Hume Highway providing
a buffer and retaining the
regional view lines.

A SUSTAINABLE TOWN

Sustainable community with an integrated stormwater and flood management system and low maintenance landscape design.

The stormwater system is strategically designed for the entire 120-hectare upstream catchment to redirect stormwater to swales, garden areas and retention basins, creating lush green spaces.





CHILDCARE & EARLY LEARNING:

New Breeze at Bardia will welcome a new Childcare Centre for the community. A Pre-DA proposal was submitted recently by Jeckra, who purchased the previous sales office land from Dahua.

Designed by COX architects, the proposed facility will cater for 122 children and 22 staff, with a basement car park of 31 spaces. Located at the corner of Malaya St and Bardia Ave, just a short walk to Bardia Public School, this new childcare centre will have a great view of the park when completed.

There are kick-about areas, open spaces where everyone can stretch their legs and feel real grass underfoot. Stroll to the nearby sports oval or explore the natura bushland trails. Various creek and picturesque picnic spots for the whole family to relax, while little ones can enjoy the play equipment and many bike trails.

Maxwell Creek Oval Precinct features a large playing oval for cricket and two full-sized fields for rugby league and soccer pursuits, a nature-based play area, flying fox, swings and slides, climbing equipment, picnic areas, shaded BBQ precincts, an amenities building and plenty of parking spaces servicing the sports facilities.

The design combines the latest in designated formal sports facilities with current trends in nature play and the creation of an immersive experience for users. Significant changes in topography across the site were accessed, resulting in slides on various grades, rope nets and rock play. There are spaces for informal recreation, picnics, and market stalls.

Maxwell Creek South Water Quality Garden is the place to go for recreational activities. Natural organic basin forms were transformed into lush rain gardens ensuring water quality control for the protection and enhancement of flora and fauna. Footpaths and bridges connect with the park entries and cross through the rain gardens, so you can enjoy the vibrant landscape while walking or cycling. There are also spaces for BBQ stations, open lawns, seating, and modern shade structures for families and friends to gather.



Bardia Park is the first park was completed in New Breeze community. It provides a soothing focus for relaxed enjoyment of nature and a place for family BBQ's.








National Park is Cumberland Plain Woodland. It's the perfect spot to see wallaroos and swamp wallabies, which are mostly seen at dawn or dusk.

Mont St Quentin Oval is part of a heritage-listed conservation area at the site of the former Ingleburn Army Camp. Located on the opposite side of Campbelltown Road to the Military Heritage Precinct, it was added to the New South Wales State Heritage Register in March 2013. \$4.5 Million construction work has started to upgrade this area. The upgrade will provide a full-sized AFL field, a new amenities building, BBQ facilities, and an inclusive children playground.

OPEN SPACES

Operation and maintenance were at the forefront of the New Breeze design process. Strategies were developed to manage storm water onsite for the entire 120-hectare upstream catchment. This involved the redirection and falling key open space areas to planted swales, garden areas, planted detention basins and most importantly the large, planted drainage channel running east- west in parallel with Bardia Avenue. The planted channels, basins and open space areas capture run off whilst providing a 'softened' solution to stormwater management.


Integrated water management and open space / landscaping in the public domain – basins and overland drainage in the corridors form part of an integrated stormwater and flood management network.

The infrastructure provides both a storage and water quality treatment role and is integrated with public open space, acting as green spines that provide passive and active recreational zones for the community.

Specific attention was given to the planting selection in the open spaces to ensure they were not only suitable for the area, but low ongoing maintenance, hardy selections and would establish quickly with limited intervention. Local CPW seed was sourced and propagated within Memorial Forest (along the Hume Highway) to help regenerate the native bushland corridor.

These areas are now thriving lush green spaces which are a testament to the detailed research and collaboration upfront by Dahua and the consultant team to ensure the success of the development. The water sensitive urban design (WSUD) is the key driver to the success of these green spaces and reduced operational and maintenance requirements.

A detention basin was also designed to attenuate stormwater runoff for events up to a 100-year average reoccurrence interval (ARI) event. However shared paths, boardwalks, exercise stations and picnic areas are all located above the five-year ARI so they are not impeded by smaller rainfall events and are safe for the community to use.




HOMES

Home rainwater harvesting systems are encouraged within the community. By collecting and storing rainwater and using it for laundry, toilet flushing, car washing and gardening, harvesting systems provide an alternative water supply for the home. Helping to reduce home water bills, and also importantly, it helps control storm water runoff and has a positive impact on the environment.
